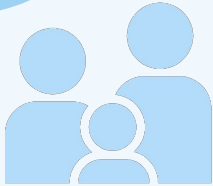




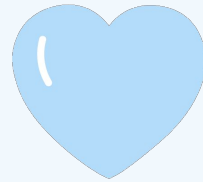

Impact

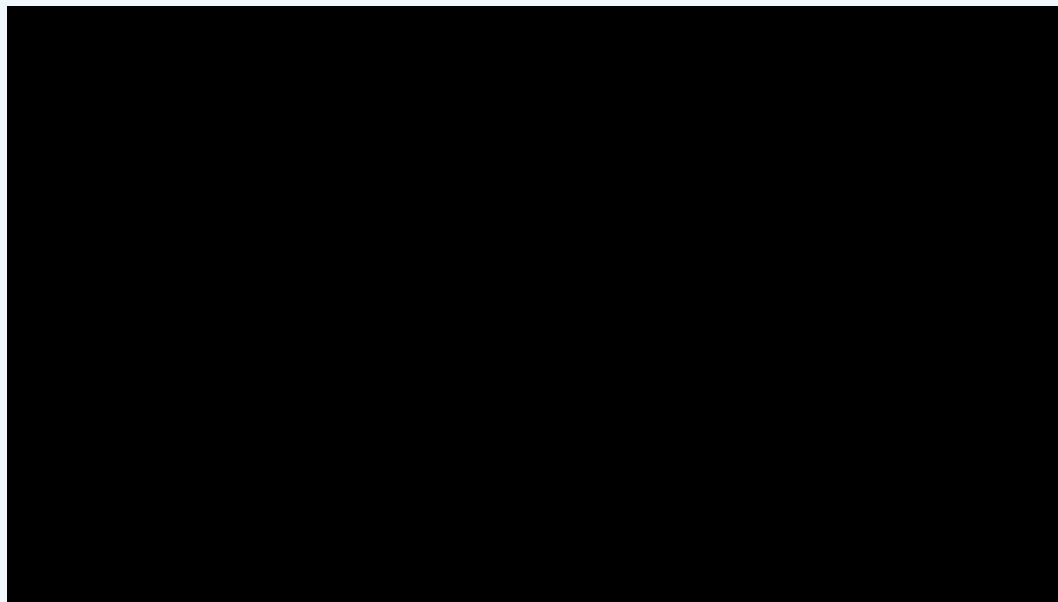
- 50+ children & families served
